Anti Racism

Rachael Gosling presented an update on work by a BAME Assembly within NHS England NW. They have produced an <u>Anti-Racist Framework</u>. Based on a set of 5 principles, it provides a maturity framework to support organisations to become anti-racist.

Screening & Immunisation

CSU are undertaking a deep dive looking at mobile breast screening sites with a view to improving uptake in vulnerable areas. Bowel screening will be available to all over 50's by the end of the financial year. 11 new Community Phamacies are offering MMR vaccination to those aged 11 to 24 across LSC (24 pharmacies offering this service in total). Work is underway with schools in key areas to pick up children who have missed any of the recommended childhood vaccinations.

Tobacco
